Safety Tips from Clearwater Police

84% of burglaries are unlocked cars. Take "valet" keys out of glove boxes. Keep valuables out of car or at least out of sight. Keep cars locked, even in your garage. Keep garage door openers out of the car or at least out of sight, as these help gain access to your home. Keep the door from garage to the house locked. Keep garage doors closed.

Clearwater Police offer a service to register your valuables and suggest you etch your name or ID on larger items: TV's, etc. Call 727-562-4242 for more information.

Storm Drains

Storm water travels through pipes underground but is not treated. Therefore, grass and leaves from lawns go directly into the drains and empty into the bay. Guard against potential flooding and the cost of unclogging these drains.
