Trailers, RV's, commercial vehicles and boats are not to remain visible on your property here in Clubhouse Estates.

Remember to lock your vehicle, per Sgt. Downes of the City Police Department. If a thief gets into your car and you have a garage door opener inside, they may then have access to your home. A vehicle on Gleneagles Dr. was broken into recently.

8:00 – Montrose via Masters to Allapattah, Hyde Park around to Hyde Park Ct, around back to Hyde Park to Fair Green
